

Q: What is going to happen on August 21?

A: You'll be receiving advising and registering for your Fall 2018 courses. Students will split into small groups (Transfer and First-Time Freshmen). An Academic Advisor from the University Advising Center will explain graduation requirements. After the presentation, you will go to a computer lab and register for classes.

International Student in F-1 Student visa status are required to enroll full-time (at least 12 units) per U.S. immigration regulation. You should be enrolled in 12 units at the end of the orientation.

Do not leave the orientation until you are enrolled in 12 units.

Q: What should I do to prepare for this advising session?

A: Logon to your Student Center and make sure you have cleared all the registration holds.

Q: What should I bring?

A: You should bring

- Copies of unofficial transcripts from every accredited institution you have attended with completed coursework
- IGETC or CSU GE transfer worksheet from community colleges
- General Education certification (if available)
- Proof of immunization (if not submitted already)
- Proof of SF State health insurance – SF State insurance must be purchased at Relation insurance: www.4studenthealth.com/sfsu-f1

Q: Is there a fee?

A: Yes. There is a \$35 fee. Once you registered for the orientation, you will receive detail information by email regarding the orientation check-in and how to pay the \$35 orientation fee in early August.
