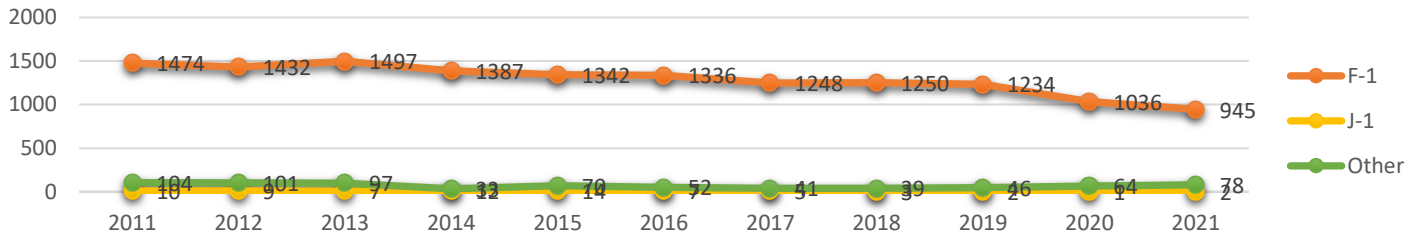

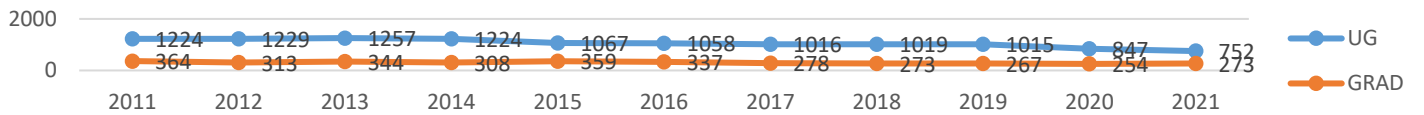

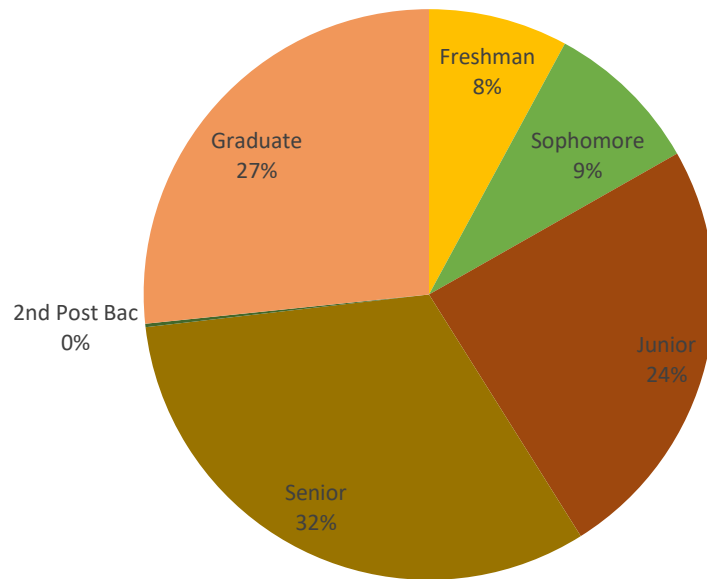
## Total Matriculated International Student Enrollment Fall 2011 - Fall 2021



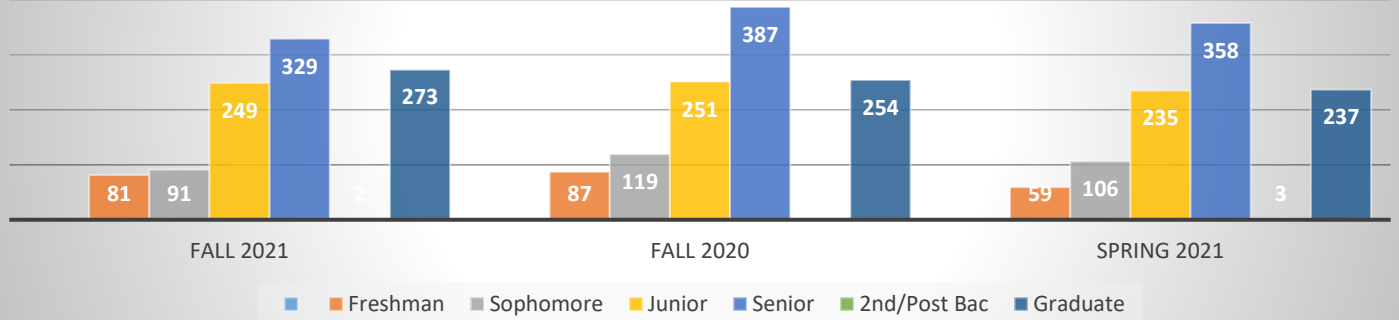
## UG/GRAD F-1 International Student Enrollment Fall...



## International Students Education Levels - Fall 2021



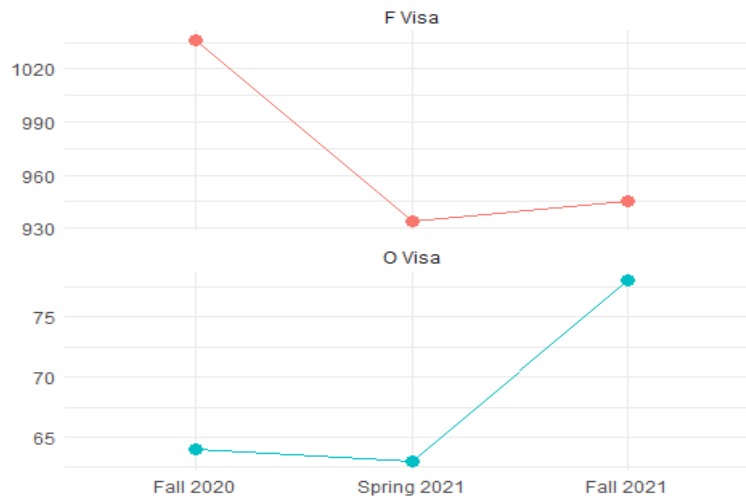
## International Students Education Levels Comparison



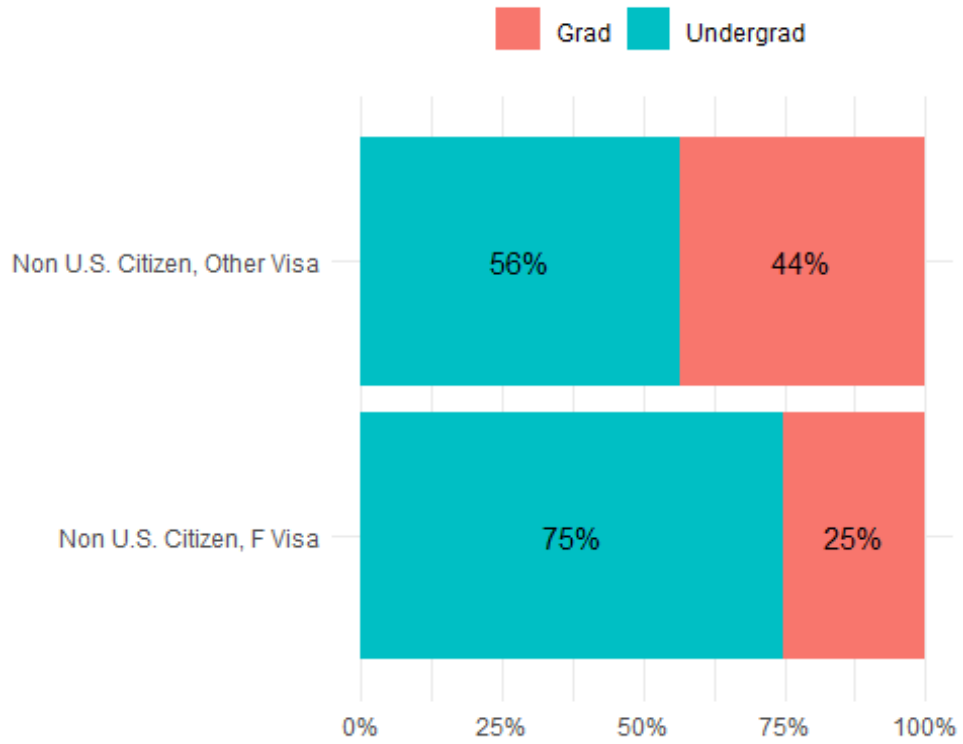

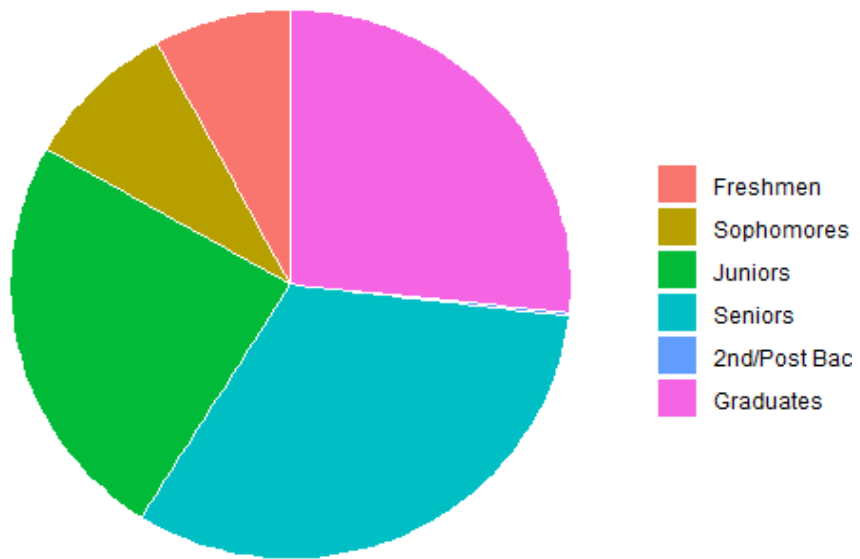

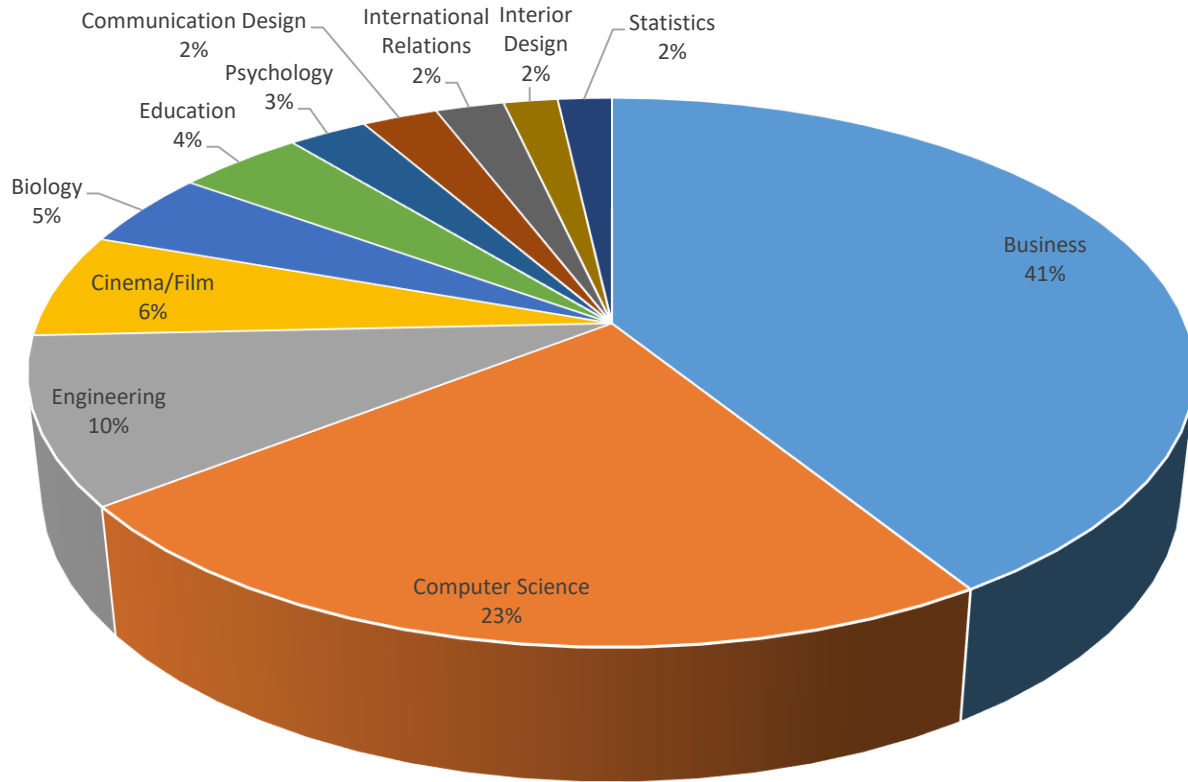

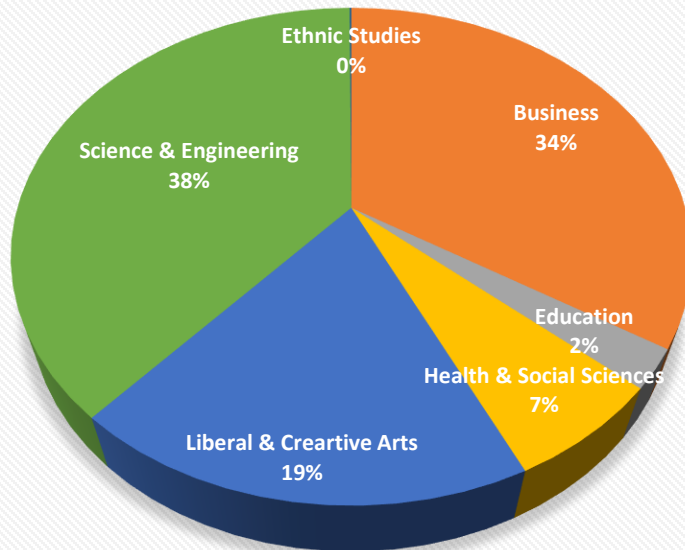
### Enrollment by Major Field of Study - Fall 2021

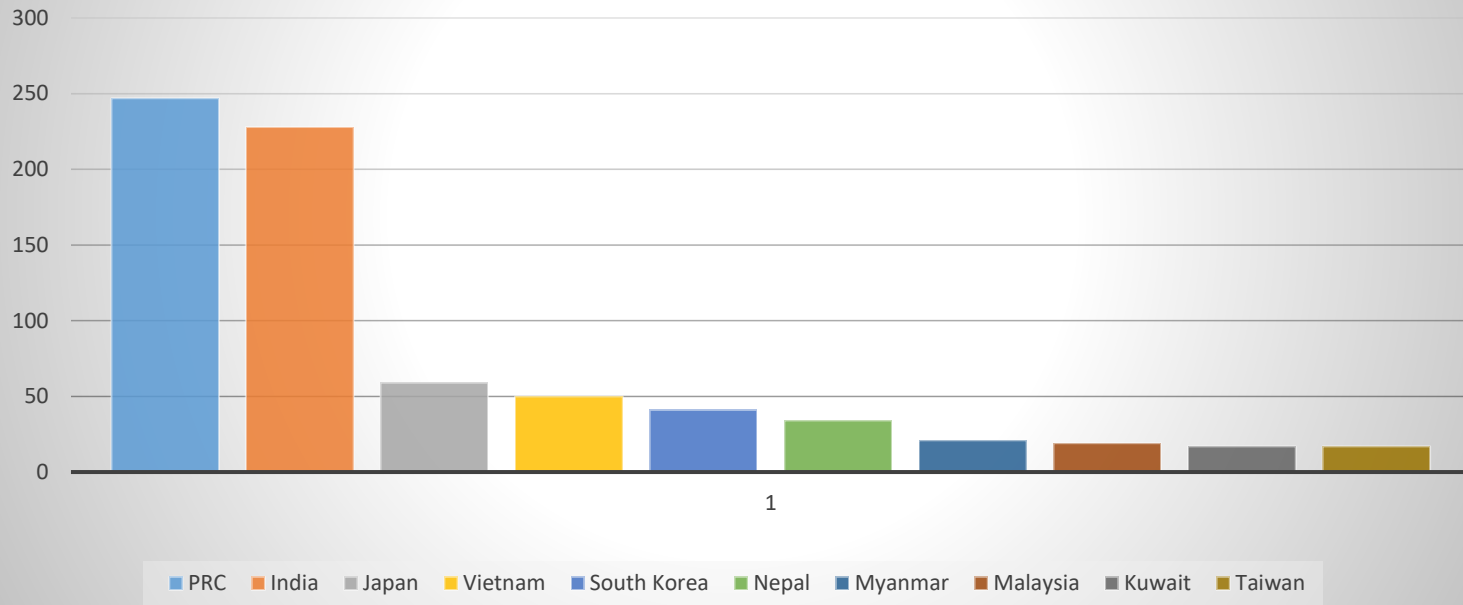
