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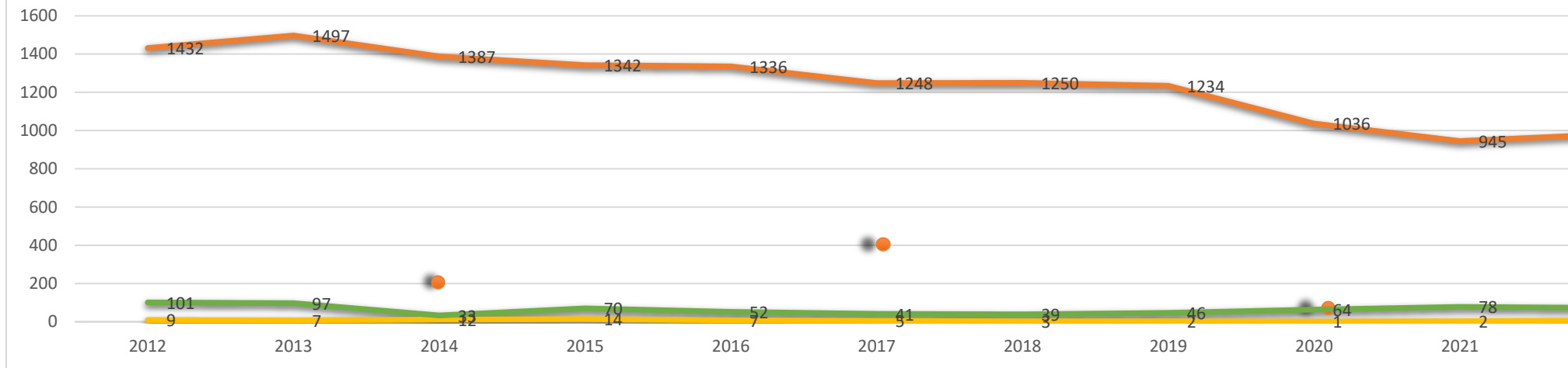

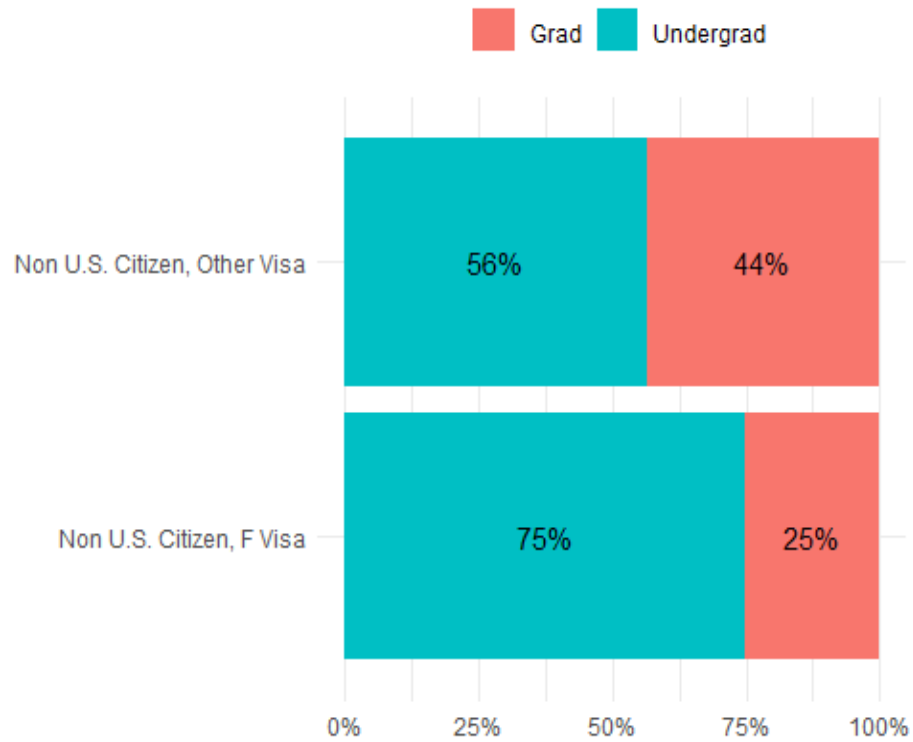

Total Matriculated International Student Enrollment Fall 2012 - Fall 2022

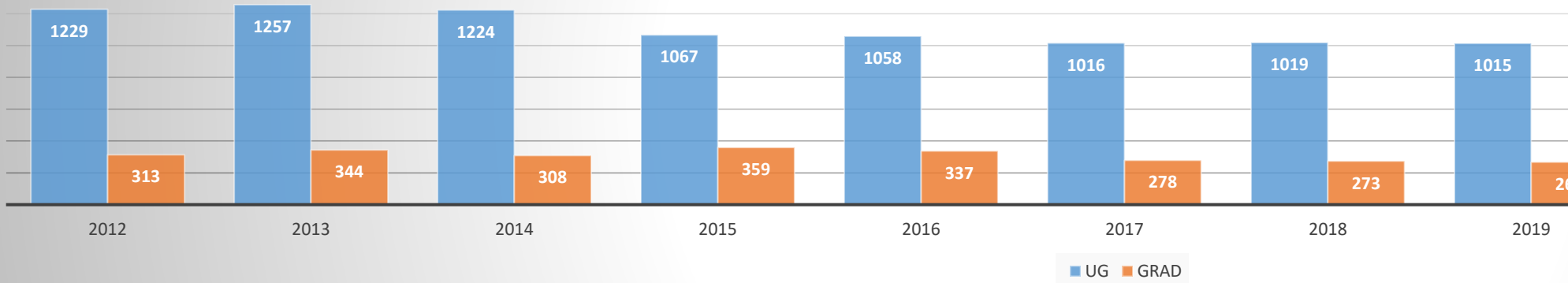

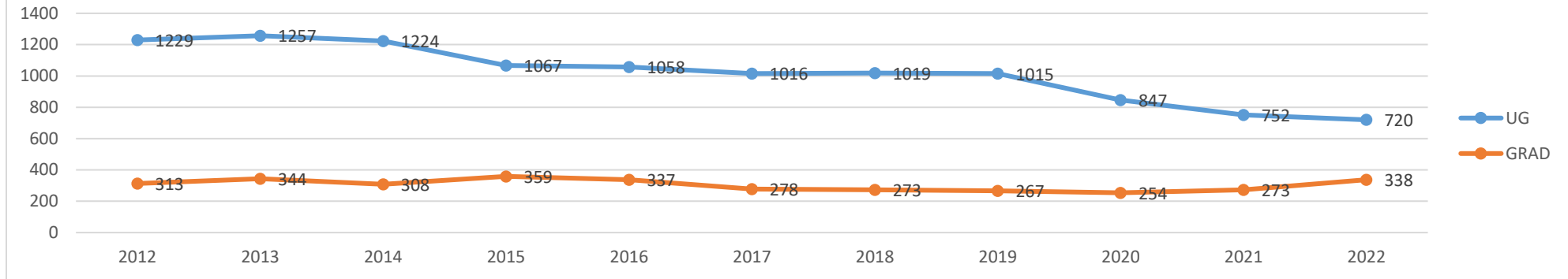

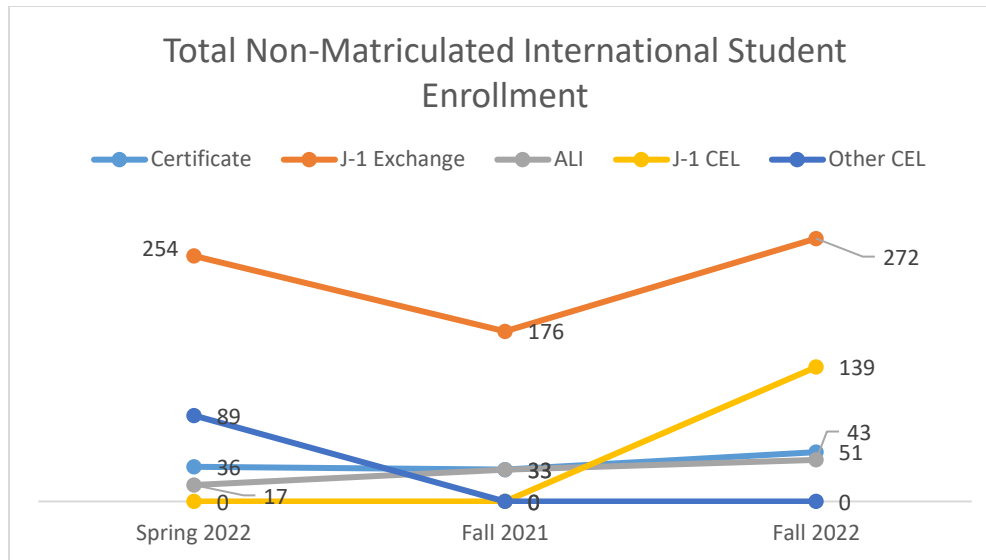

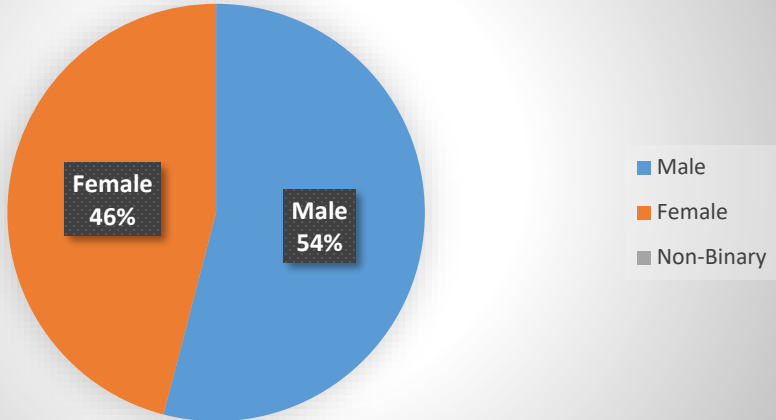

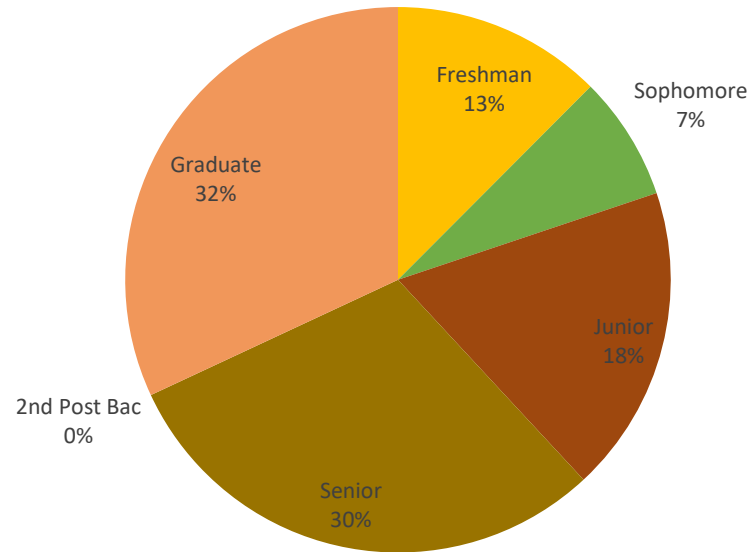
Enrollment by Gender - Fall 2022

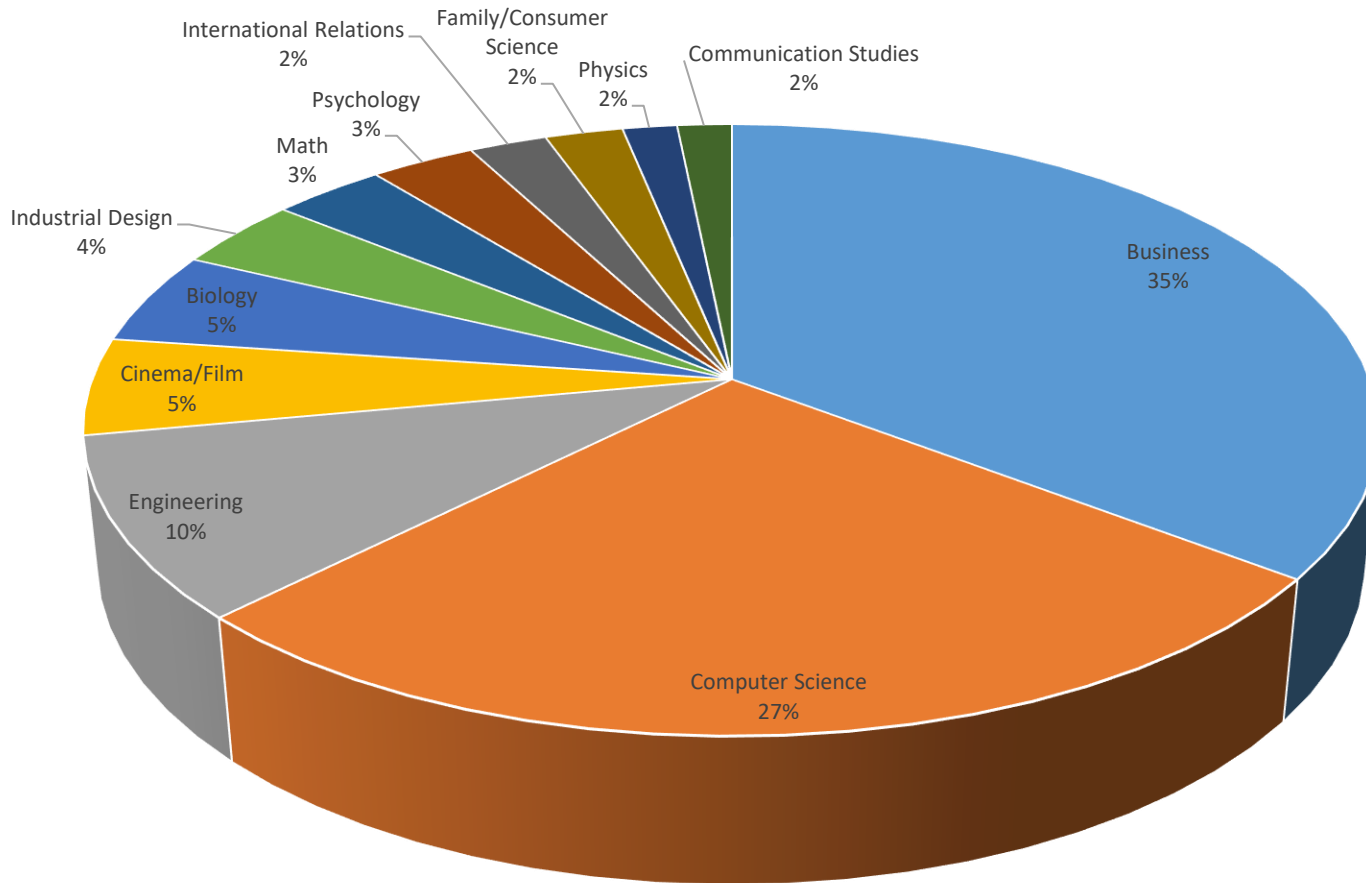

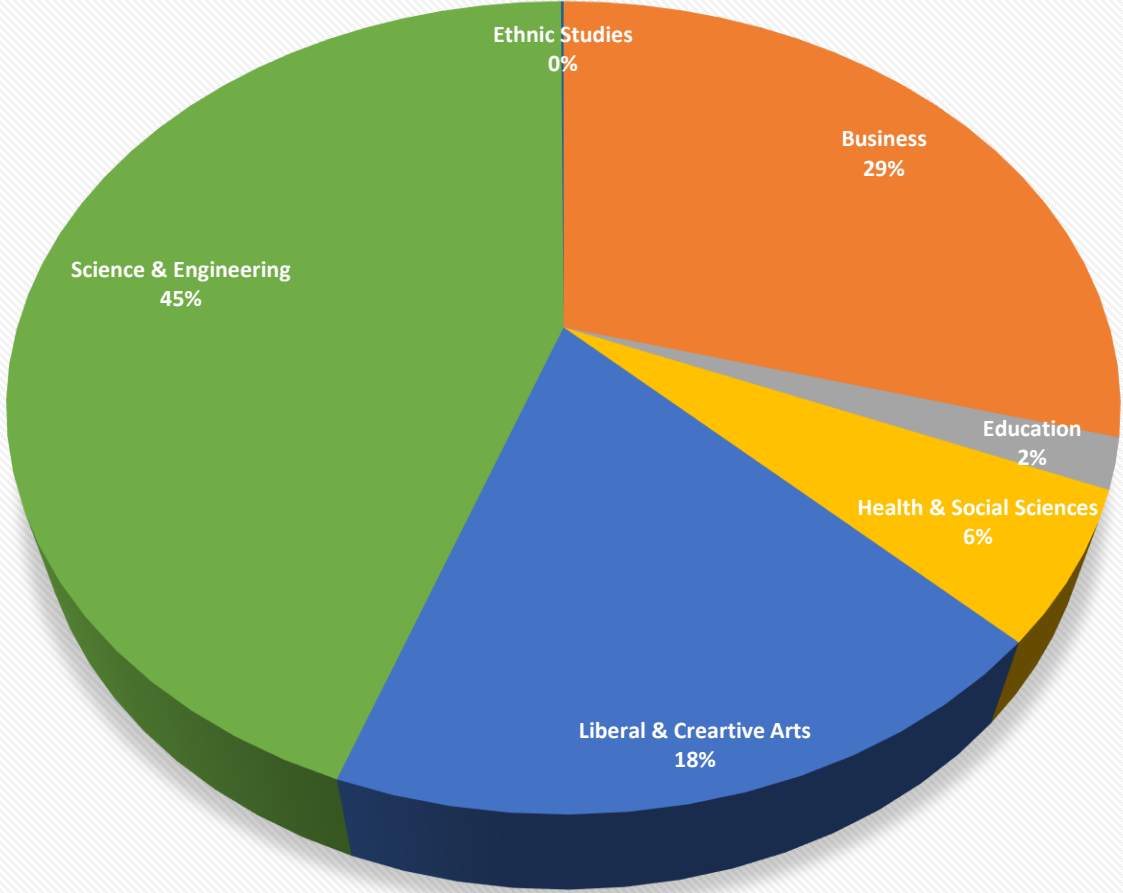
Enrollment by Major Field of Study - Fall 2022

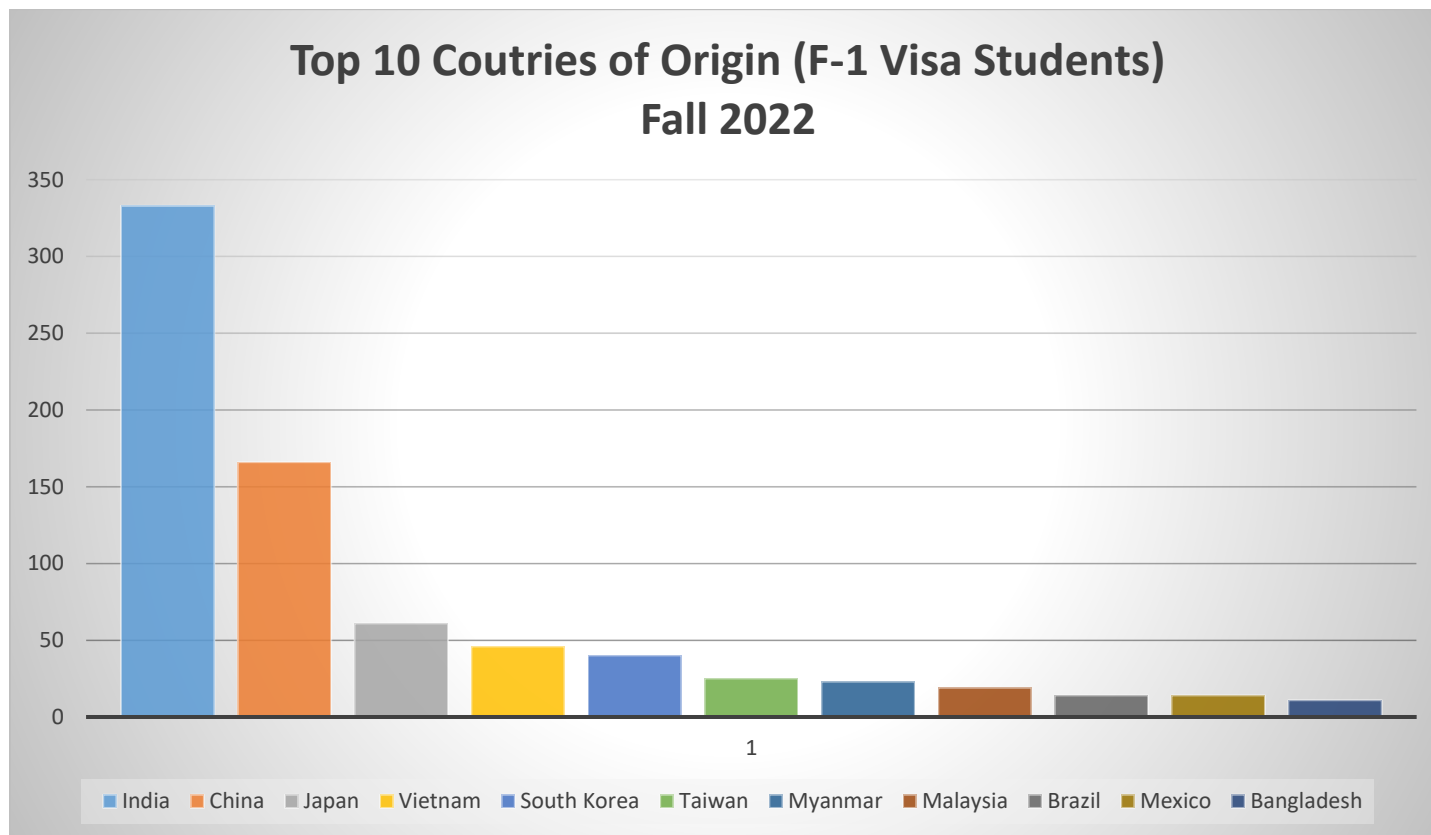

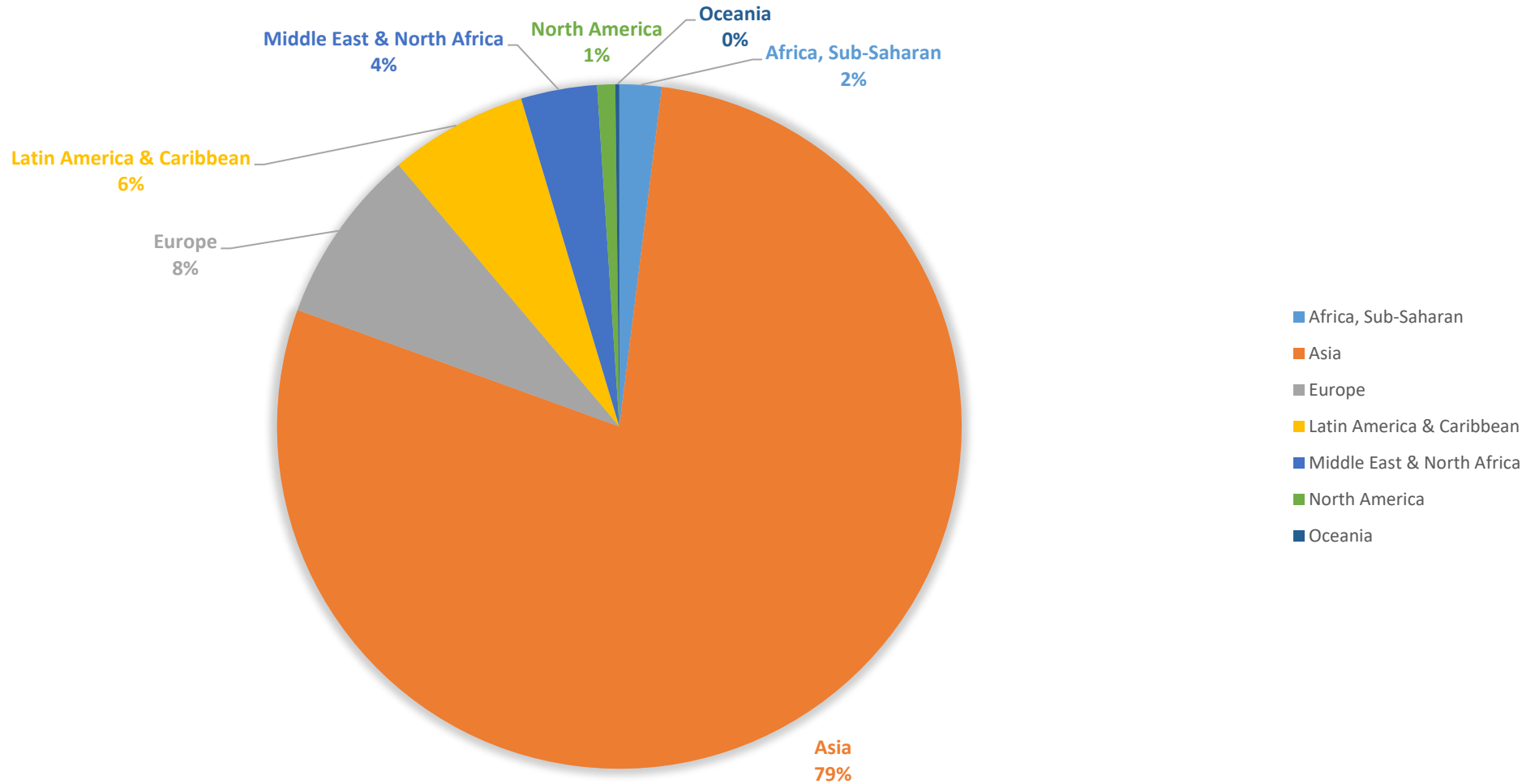

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS REGIONS OF ORIGIN - FALL 2022



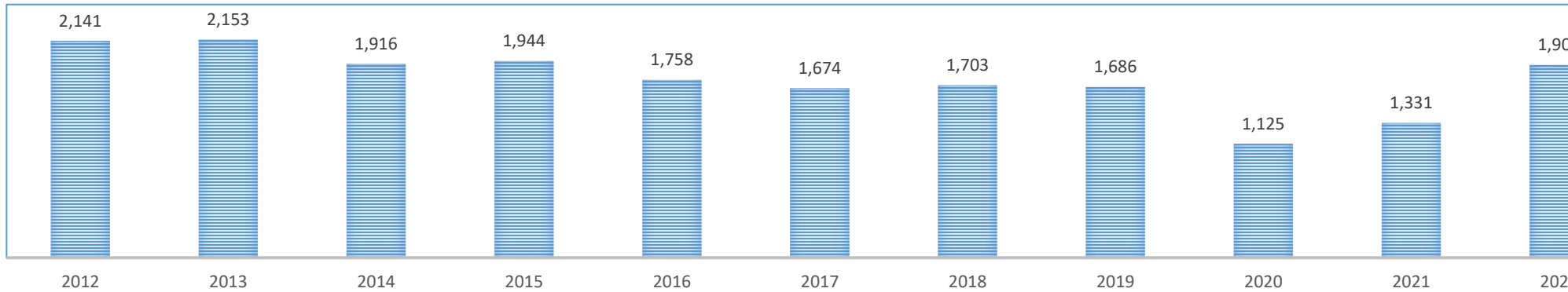
