



# **On-Campus Housing Application**

- SF State University Housing will begin to accept applications on March 1 for the fall semester. It is on first-come, first-served basis.
- Students will need a SF State ID number to apply for on-campus housing. Applicants should receive a SF State ID number in approximately 5 business days after submitting the online Cal State Apply Application.

### **Admission Criteria**

#### Undergraduate

- Secondary School/High School transcripts, proof of graduation
- ALL post-secondary academic transcripts
- 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale
- TOEFL minimum iBT 61 or
- IELTS minimum 6.0
- Some high demand majors may require higher GPAs

#### Graduate

- 4-year bachelor degree
- 3.0 GPA on 4.0 scale
- College/University Transcripts
- TOEFL minimum iBT 80 (88 for MBA, 95 for TESOL) or
- IELTS minimum 6.5 (7.0 for TESOL)
- GRE/GMAT (Computer Science & Bus)
- Personal Statement
- 2 Letters of Recommendation

Some majors do not accept spring applications High Demand programs may have earlier deadline

## **Undergraduate Programs**

### Impacted/High Demand Majors

Major impaction means that the number of applications from fully eligible students to a designated major far exceeds the number of spaces available in that major

Non-residents of California and international applicants must meet higher minimum admission requirements

- When communicating with SF State, please be sure to include the student's complete name and SF State Student ID Number!
- Be sure that all F-1 visa applicants answer "Yes" to the International Applicant question in the Extended Profile section: "Do you have or will you require an F1 visa or J1 visa to study at the California State University (CSU)?

- In the Personal Information quadrant, "Citizen/Residency Information": International Additional Information "Provide the name of the third party organization or the individual you are working with to complete this application"
- First/Name Given Name: Name of advisor/counselor/agent
- Last Name/Family name: Agency's Name
- What year did you move to the U.S.?: Leave blank
- If you are currently an active F-1 student, enter your SEVIS number: Leave Blank

- In the Program Material quadrant, click on the Academic major that the applicant selected, then select "Documents": Instructions for uploading documents are on this page.
- Please do not send any supporting paper documents (transcripts, test scores, etc.) to SF State until AFTER the student has completed the online Cal State Apply application and has actually applied to SF State!

- It is very important to upload ALL materials to the Cal State Apply online application
- If agents/students send documents one at a time by post/email, it will significantly slow down the application review process
- Therefore, please use the online application to its full potential
- Once you have successfully uploaded all required documents into Cal State Apply, you do not need to also send us the very same documents via post/email

### **Agent Information**

Agents/students can use the ADD documents button on the "Program Materials" section of the application to upload:

- Clear, legible PDF copies of both English and native language versions of certificates, graduation certificates, bachelor's/master's degree certificates and transcripts; or
- 2. Clear, legible PDF copies of both English and native language versions of transcripts showing at least 6 semesters of coursework (for those who are in progress-or future graduates)

- Cam Scanners are not a good method for scanning documents as they do not offer a clear, legible high quality scan to proceed with an application review
- SF State will reject documents that are scanned using a cam scanner
- TOEFL, PTE or IELTS score reports should contain a photo and also be a high quality scan upload to the document section of the Cal State Apply online application

### **Agent Information**

- Graduate applicants should make use of the "Letter of Recommendation" feature for managing the collection of letters
- Students must enter the details of the recommender into Cal State Apply before the application can be submitted

# Online Cal State Apply Application: Student Consent Form

- All official partner-agents with San Francisco State
   University are required to submit a completed "Student Consent for Release of Information Form" for each applicant
- Please upload the "Student Consent Form" into the section "Other" section for each applicant. (A few MA/MS majors will not have "Other" so upload the Student Consent form in the "Transcript" section)

# U.S. Immigration Service Policies Regarding the Form I-20





## San Francisco State University

U.S. Immigration Service Policy on Recruiters and the Form I-20

- The U.S. Immigration Service requires that for reasons of privacy, security and fraud prevention, the Form I-20 must be issued directly by the school to the student.
- As a result, SF State is not able to send a student's I-20 form to any of our agent partners. Regulations require that we sent the I-20 form directly to the student only. Therefore, please be sure to include the student's home mailing address in the Cal State Apply online application.

### **SF State Agent Commission Process**





#### Undergraduate/Graduate Degree Programs

- \$500 per semester/per student for the 1<sup>st</sup> two consecutive semesters of full-time enrollment (Total of \$1,000/student)
- Invoices are processed after the last day to withdraw from classes for that semester (end of October for Fall Semester; early April for Spring Semester); We will contact you when we are ready to start accepting & processing invoices each semester

#### Undergraduate/Graduate Degree Programs

- Students cannot owe the university any \$
- Invoices should be received by SF State within 60 days of request
- Invoices will be paid by SF State within 60 days of receipt

ALI/CEL Non-Degree Programs

- ALI Students: 15% of ALI tuition fees for the first two consecutive sessions of fulltime enrollment
- Certificate & Non-Degree Students:
   15% of all tuition for the first two consecutive semesters that the student maintains full-time status and has the SF State tuition fees fully paid

- Students cannot owe the university any \$
- Invoices should be received by SF State within 60 days of request
- Invoices will be paid by SF State within 60 days of receipt

#### **Maximize Your Agent Commission!**

 Possible to receive an agent commission for the same student who completes two consecutive semesters at ALI and then completes 2 consecutive semesters in an SF State degree program

- Invoices must be on the agency's letterhead stationary & contain the following information:
- 1. Amount due to agency for each student
- 2. Student's complete family & given names
- 3. Date of first enrolled term at SF State
- 4. Student's SF State ID number

- 5. Specific program in which student is enrolled
- 6. Address for payment, telephone, fax and email details of the agency
- 7. For payment by wire transfer:
- ✓ Beneficiary Name (Account Holder)
- ✓ Account Number
- ✓ Complete Address of Account Owner

- ✓ Name of Bank, Bank SWIFT Code (Bank Identifier Code, BIC)
- √ Full address of the bank or branch address
- ✓ Invoice or reference number
- √ Any additional info requested by SF State

- Student cannot be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Must hold F-1 student visa

#### **Conditional Admission**

(Undergraduate Programs Only)

- Meet Academic requirements HS Diploma or proof of graduation and 2.5 GPA
- Students receive Conditional Admission Letter to non-impacted undergraduate program
- American Language Institute begin studies at ALI
- UG enters academic degree program after ALI required level with teacher's recommendation
- Grad must be reviewed and offered decision by graduate department faculty after ALI
