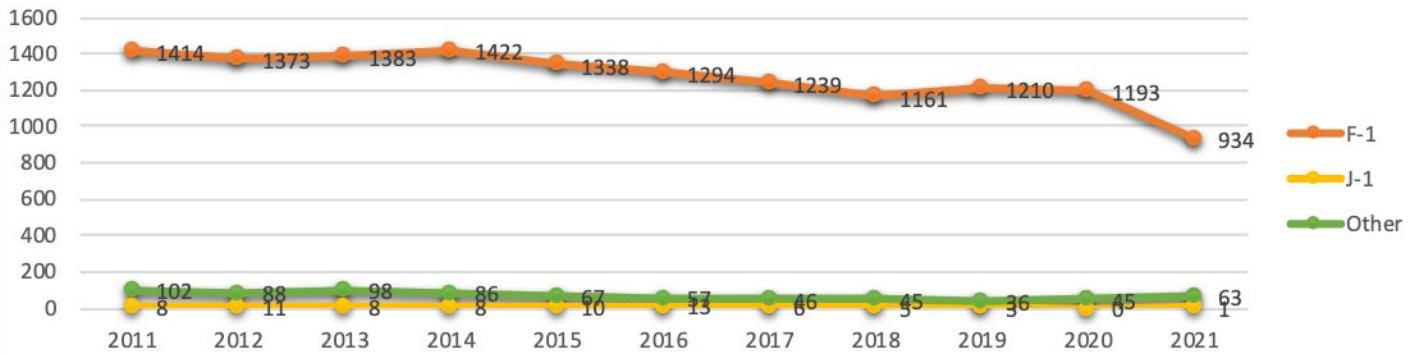

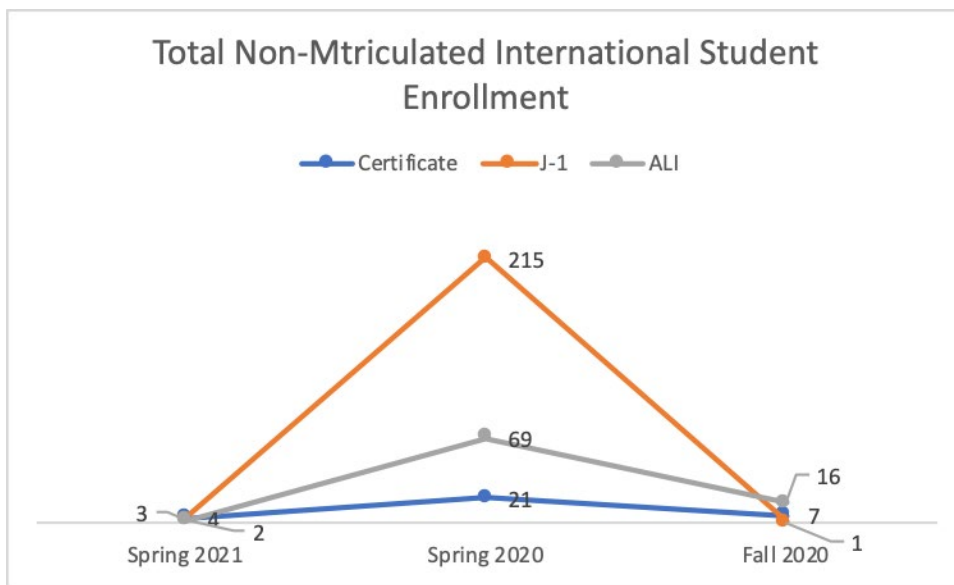

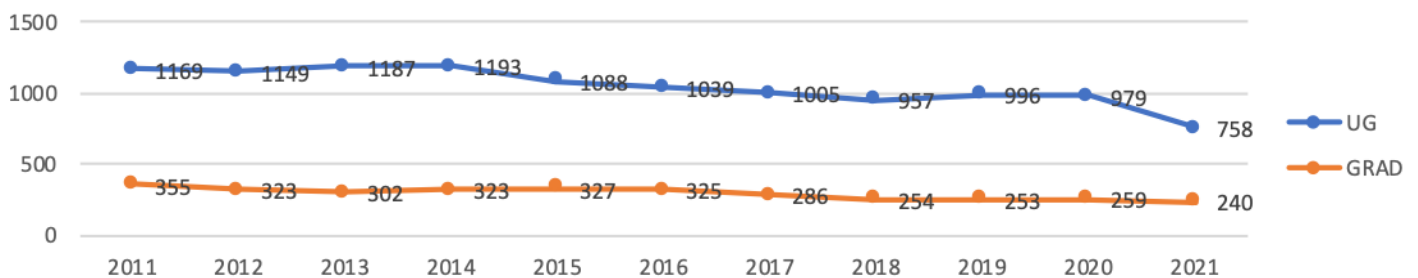
## Total Matriculated International Student Enrollment Spring 2011 - Spring 2021



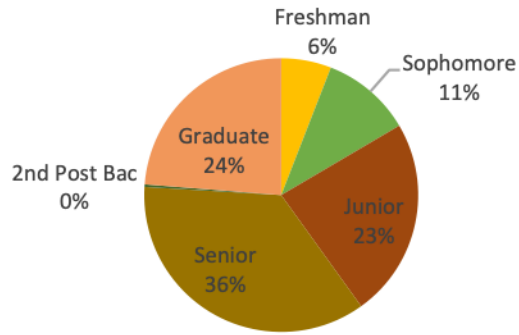
## Total Non-Matriculated International Student Enrollment



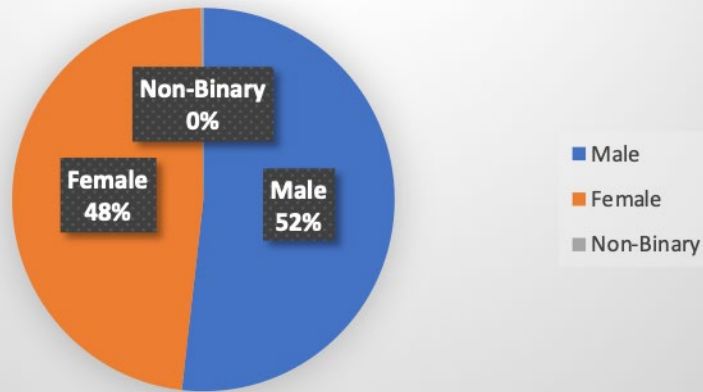
## UG/GRAD F-1 International Student Enrollment Spring 2011 - Spring 2021



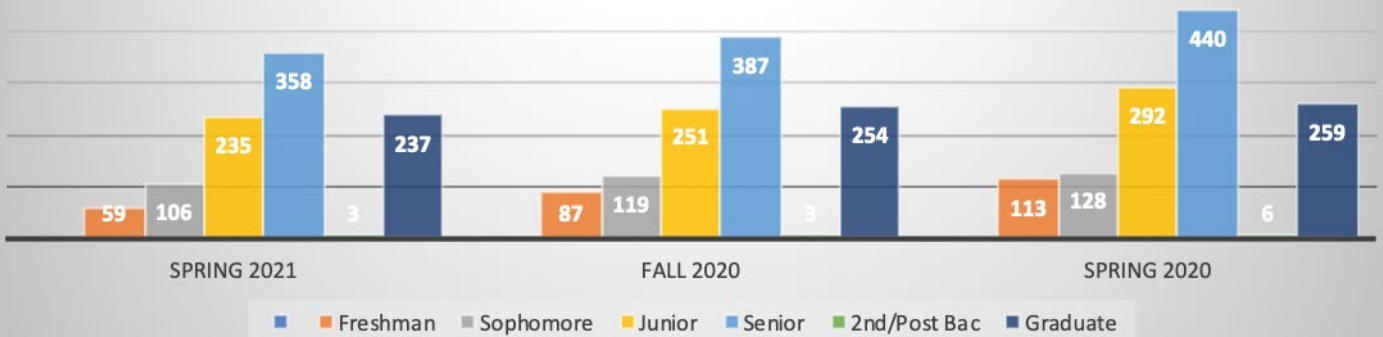
### International Students Education Levels - Spring 2021



### Enrollment by Gender - Spring 2021



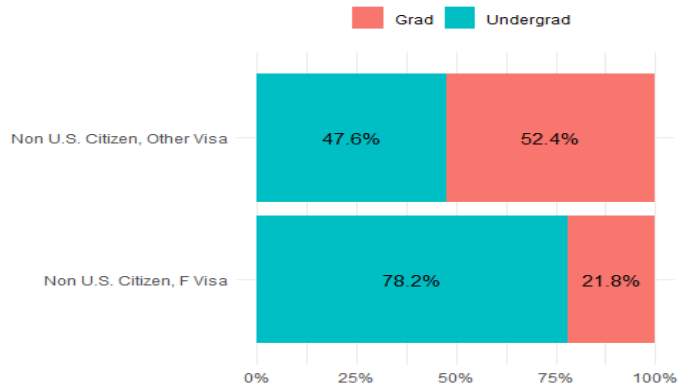
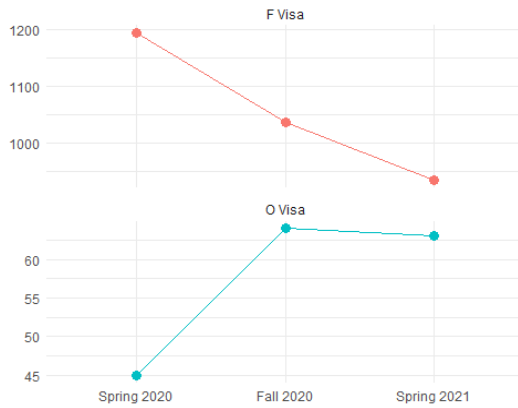

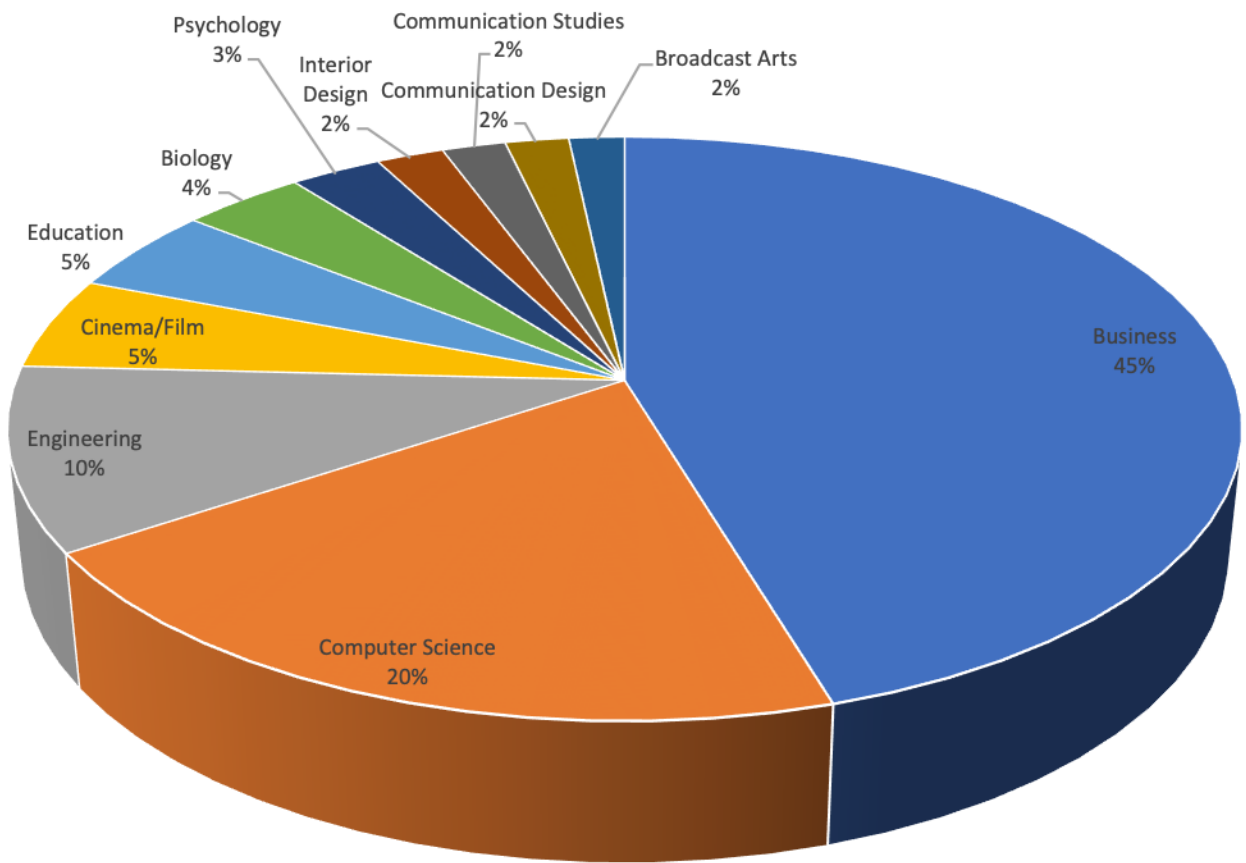

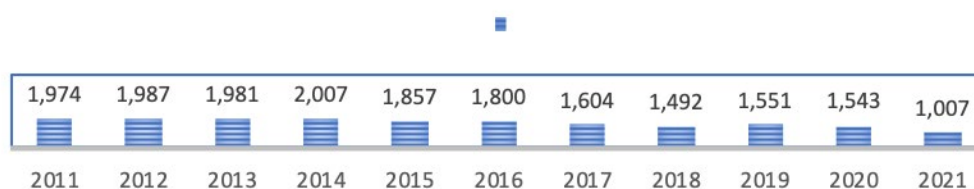
