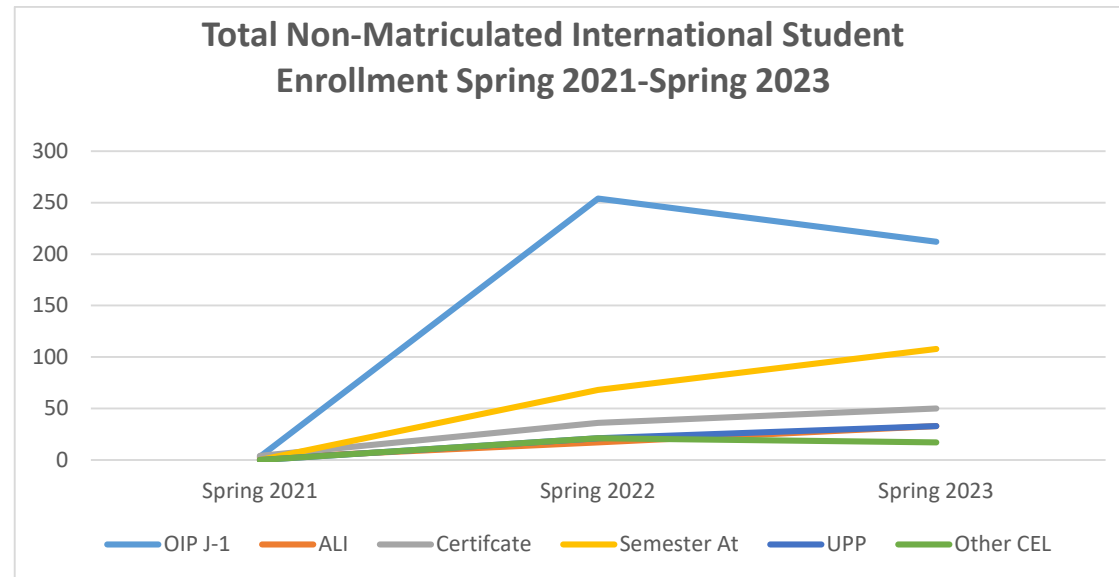

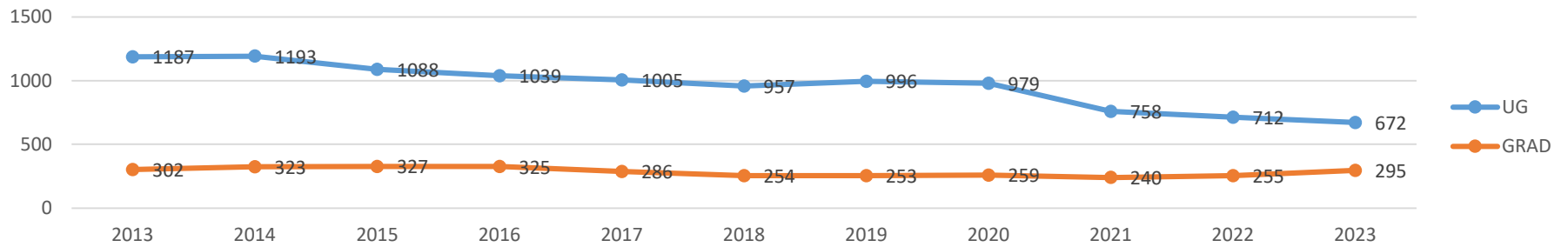

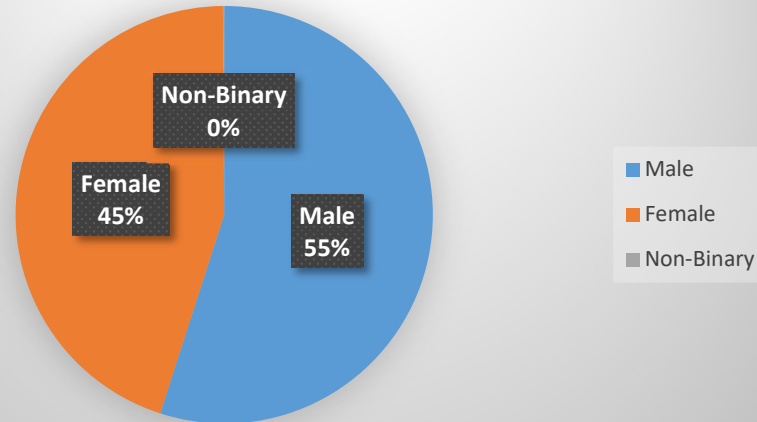
UG/GRAD F-1 International Student Enrollment Spring 2013 - Spring 2023

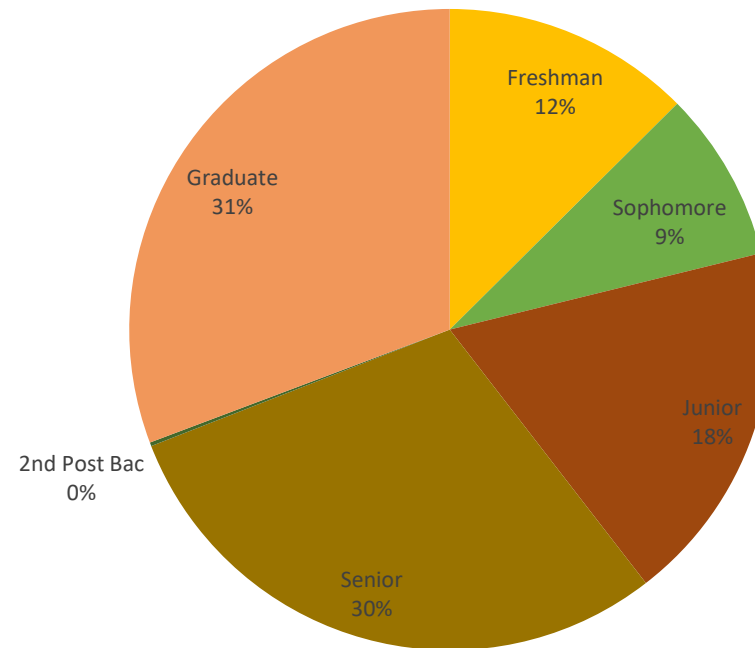
Enrollment by Gender - Spring 2023

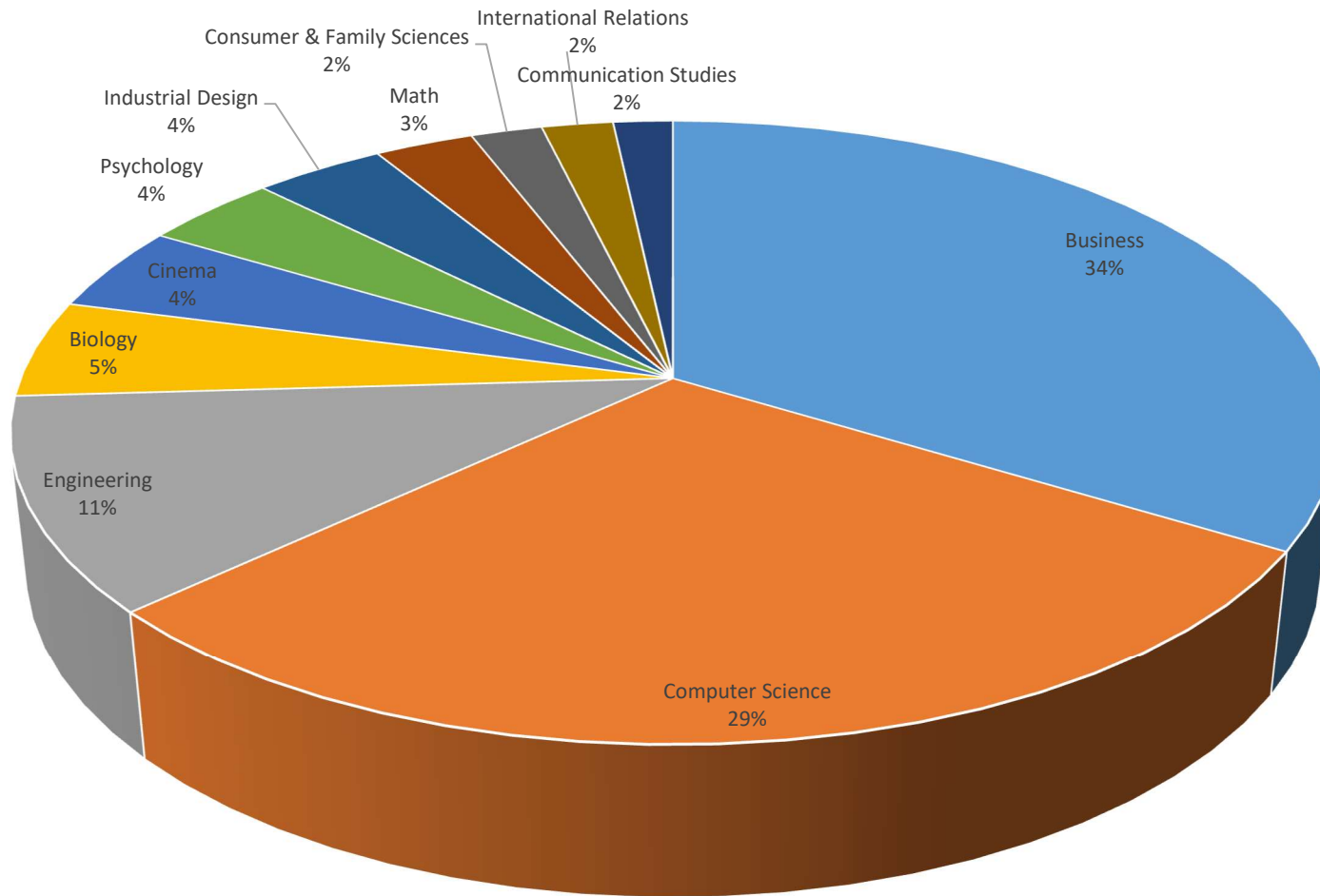

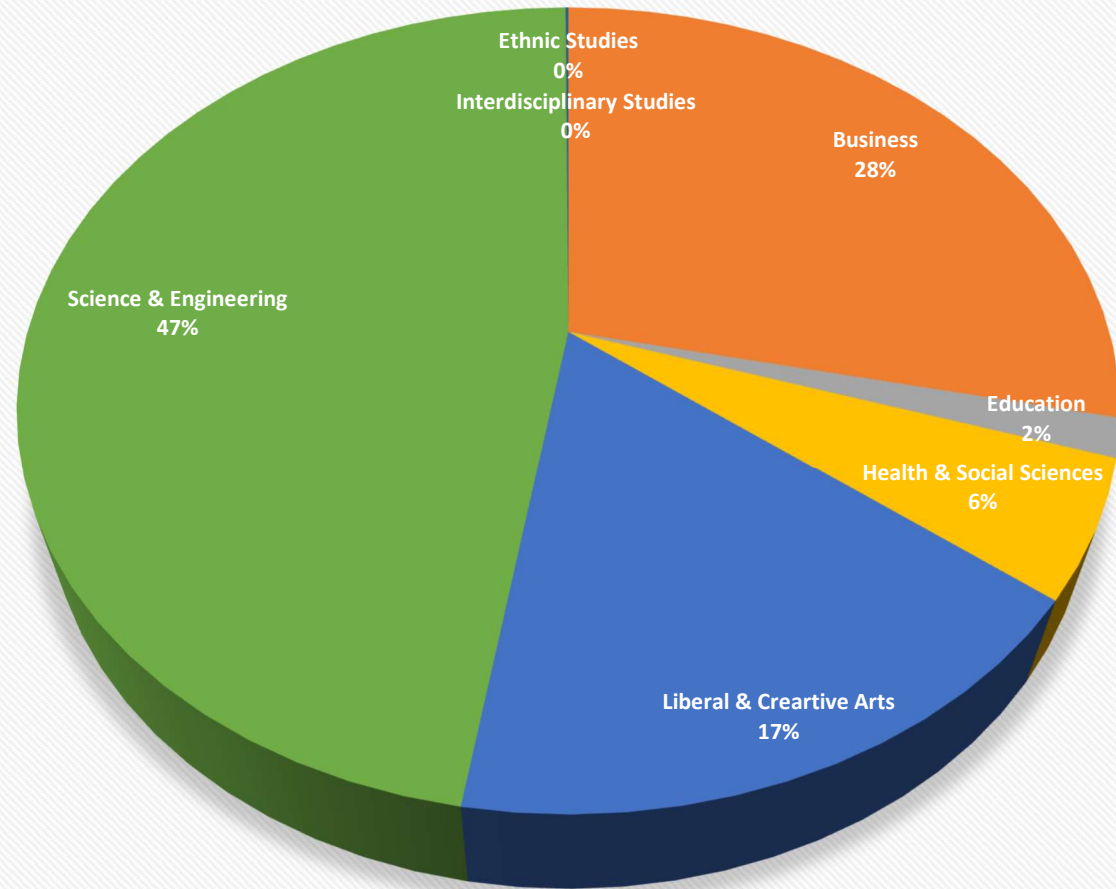
Enrollment by Major Field of Study - Spring 2023

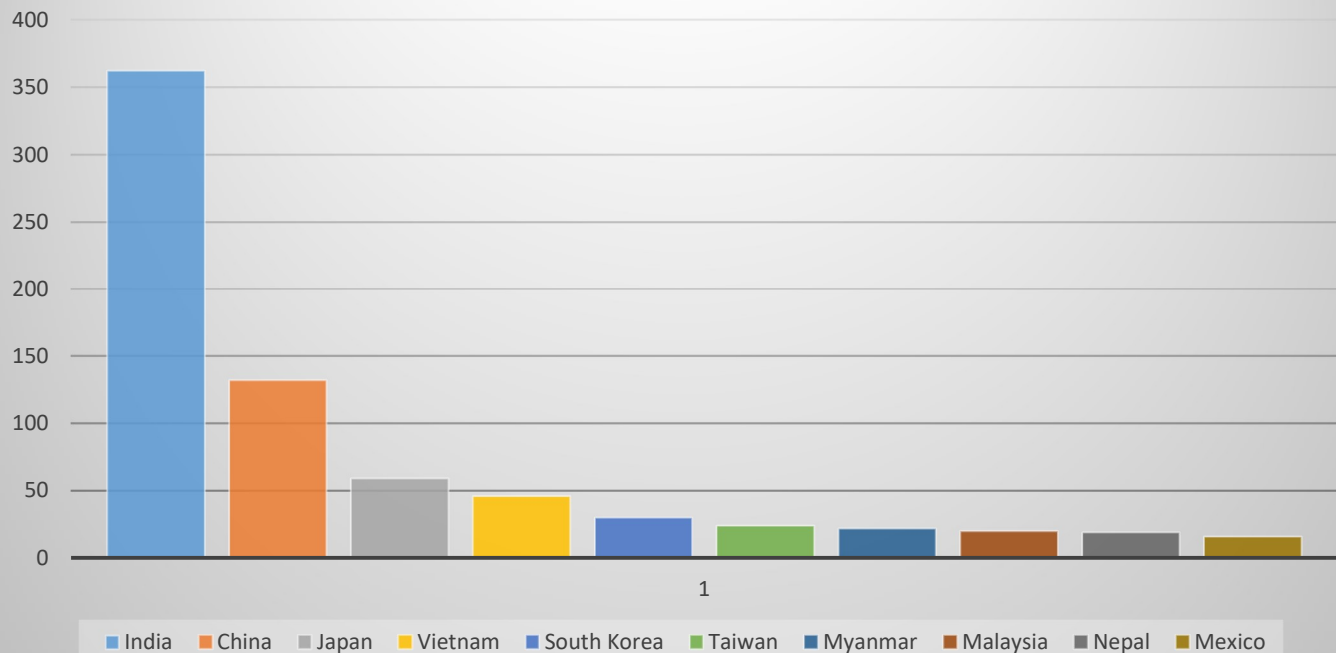

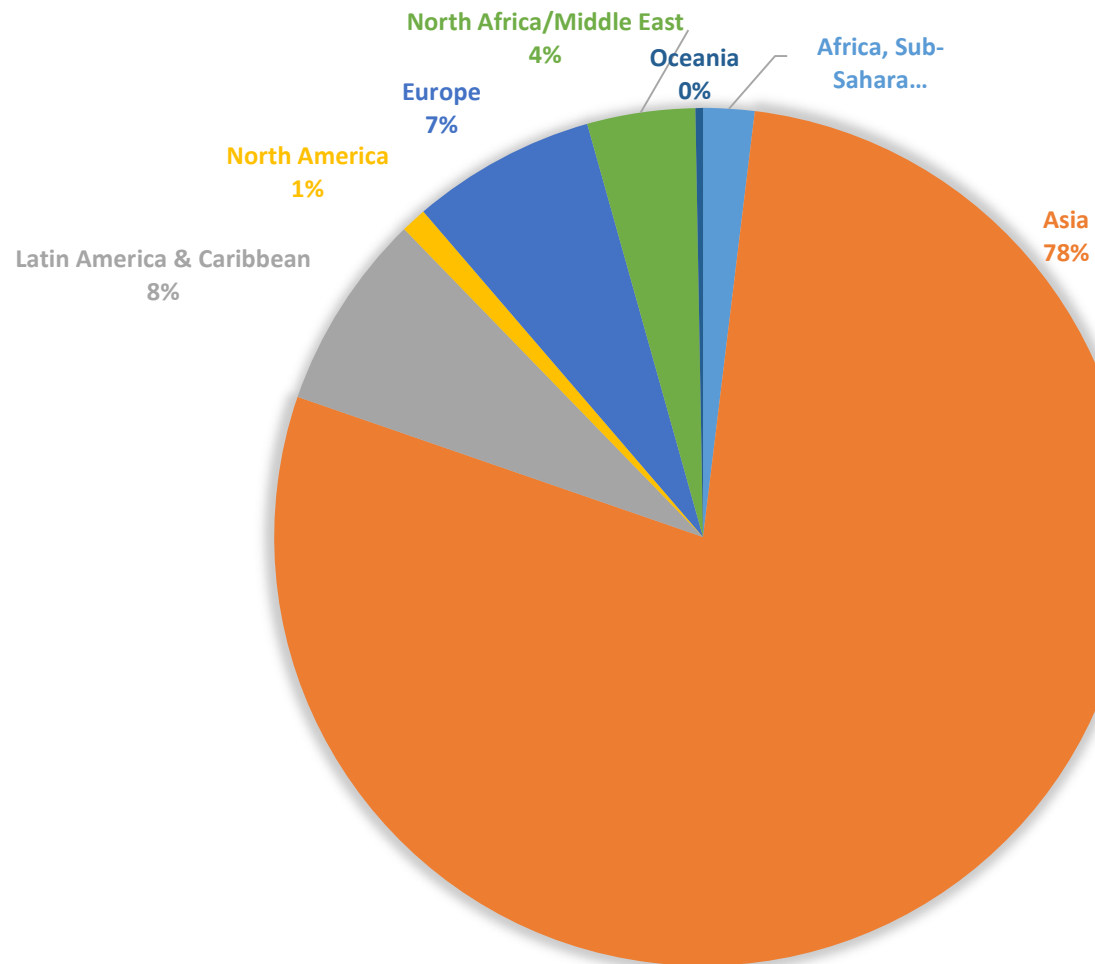

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS REGIONS OF ORIGIN - SPRING 2023



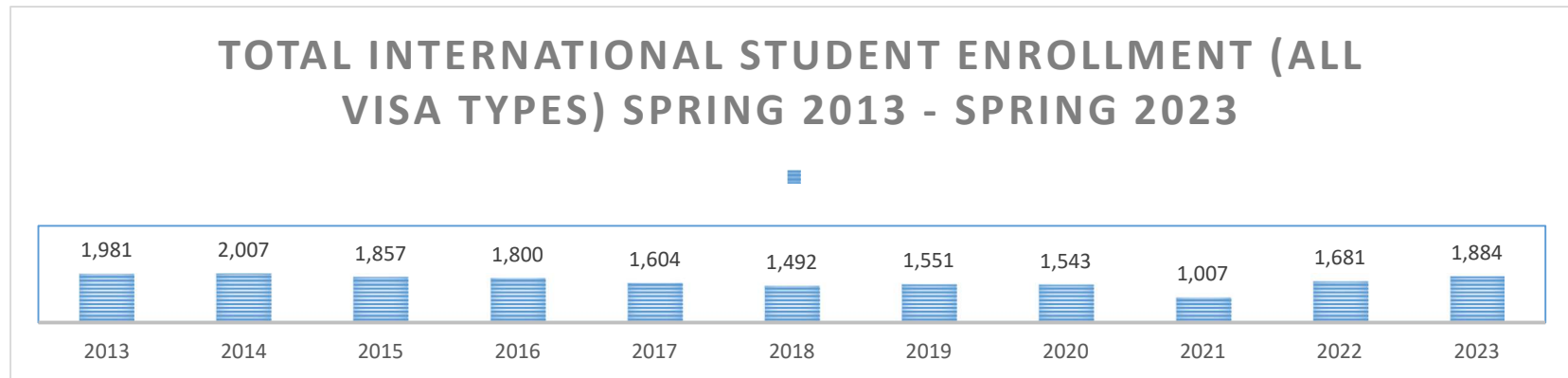
